

Christian Educator

Saint Andrew's (Episcopal) Parish in Kent, Connecticut, seeks to hire a permanent part-time **Christian Educator**. Saint Andrew's is embarking on a mission to more actively serve all who live in and around the Town of Kent, and this includes families with school-age children, many of whom have relocated to Kent in the last year or two. We are eager to re-establish St Andrew's as a place in the community where parents may bring their children to receive Christian education and/or participate in wholesome, fun afterschool activities. Our new Christian Educator will lead and oversee these efforts.

Qualifications

- Education
 - High school diploma; some college preferred
- Faith:
 - A practicing Christian
 - A member of The Episcopal Church *or* familiarity with the Church's teachings and liturgy
- Experience and skills
 - Meaningful experience (either professional or volunteer) as a teacher, youth coordinator, counselor, etc
 - Working knowledge of MS Office applications
 - Familiarity with the value and use of social media (e-newsletters, Facebook, etc)

Responsibilities

- *Christian Education*
 - In consultation with the Priest-in-Charge, select, teach and/or shepherd a weekly (35 – 40-minute) Christian education curriculum (Scripture, liturgy, seasons of the church year, etc) for children
 - Recruit volunteers to teach and/or assist
- *Fellowship*
 - Create and staff one mid-week afterschool offering (1-2 hours) for children
 - Content may vary, at the Coordinator's discretion: crafts, games, movies, local outings, music, play-time, simple volunteer activities, etc
 - Recruit volunteers to supervise and/or assist
- *Outreach*
 - Continually reach out to the greater Kent community to publicize these offerings and attract interested families

Details

- Position begins immediately
- Reports to St Andrew's Priest-in-Charge
 - Weekly conversations for planning and coordination
- Year-round position
- Ten hours per week (which includes planning and prep time), with paid vacation
- Compensation: \$15,000 per year
- Employment subject to successful completion of a thorough background check and diocesan Safe Church training
