#### THE COMMON CUP



Following Bishop Ahrens' visit in May, when she asked us to consider returning to drinking from the common cup, a sacrament of the unity and acceptance among all who follow Jesus Christ, the vestry determined it was time to do so. Since May, that has been our eucharistic practice. We do remind you that receiving the sacrament in one form represents full participation in the eucharistic meal.






