Holy Week is, to say the least, intense. It began with the altar and coverings for the crosses changing from the deep purple of Lent to the crimson of Palm Sunday and the palms being blessed. Then that very long Gospel reading, in which the entire week was spelled out.

Thursday all of the furnishings of the chancel and sanctuary were removed, with that crimson frontal being folded up last and taken out of the nave. The altar was washed, and we left in silence.

Friday worshippers found the church with the cross suspended over a bare altar draped in black. A Gospel full of humiliation and rejection, then the solemn collects and communion from the reserved sacrament. There is no blessing or dismissal, just all of us leaving, again in silence.

It's a lot to pray about in one week, with a bit of theatre added to dramatize the message of pain and sacrifice. Faith carries us through to Sunday, when, like the mourners going to the tomb, we are met with a glorious sight of white flowers and vestments, beautiful music and the message of salvation.






